



Lillian, 49, is a widow and has a daughter 16. She is obese, has diabetes and other problems that come with these illnesses. She works as a vendor in a makeshift location outside a supermarket. She sells tissues, candy, cookies, crackers, etc. She is strong and works hard and long hours to earn enough to get by. This is the third wheelchair that she has received from the ministry. The problem is due to the terrain where she lives and works. The streets are not paved and filled with rocks and debris. You can just imagine what happens in the rain.



This gentleman (at left) participates in a senior program in his community. He recently had an amputation and needed a wheelchair to be able to get around. Without the help of the ministry he would be left at home in bed.

Chile has progressed in their treatment of seniors and people with special needs. But they still have a long way to go. There are many who fall through the cracks.

For example, Jessenia (pictured below), 39, was born with congenital special needs, speech and developmental disabilities. She is too old to be helped by the Chilean Telethon (modeled after the Jerry Lewis MD Telethon). They only help children up to 18 years of age. She is also not eligible for the Seniors program because she is not old enough.



Her family is poor and she needs constant medical attention. Recently she stopped walking. So the ministry solved the problem by fitting her with a wheelchair.

Praise God for the ministries in Peru, Chile, Bolivia and Uruguay that are helping these needs.
