

a friend will help him to read the Bible he received. Clara also presented the Gospel to José, he prayed, but now he needs to be fed from the Word of God.

~Dominican Republic~

FRIDLA finally had the opportunity to send our first chair to the Dominican Republic. We were contacted by a pastor who has a church in Boston. He is originally from the Dominican Republic. We sent him the forms to obtain the necessary information and a picture of Sibeli, age 29.

Sibeli had polio as a child. Her family is very poor and there was no hope of her ever having any type of a wheelchair. Also, the rocky terrain where she lives prohibited moving around in a regular wheelchair. The pastor requested a power chair for her.

Using the measurements from the documents, Alberto was able to find a power chair that was high enough to go over the rough terrain. The chair was then shipped to Boston to the pastor who took it with him when he made a trip to the Dominican Republic.
